

Mini Windmills

Items you'll need:

- A Ruler
- A4 card
- A Wooden Skewer
- An earring or thumb tack
- Modelling clay or blue tack
- Scissors
- A Gluestick

1. Take the piece of card and measure out a 5inch by 5inch square.
2. Fold over one corner of the square to the corner diagonal to it.
3. Do the same to the other corner of the square.
4. Take your pencil and ruler, and mark 2 inches from each corner of the square, to the centre.
5. Cut along the folds you've made until you reach the mark you've made earlier.
6. Take one corner of the square and stick it to the centre of the square.
7. Do the same for the other three corners.
8. Once you've finished sticking all of the corners, you should have the general shape of your windmill completed.
9. Push the thumb tack/earring through the centre of the square.
10. Stick the blue tack/clay to the end of the wooden skewer.
11. Stick the earring through the clay/blue tack and secure the windmill in place. Make sure to leave a little space between the windmill and the clay, so that the windmill has room to turn.
